This letter is to confirm Morning Pride's policy on additional helmet markings and/or accessories (i.e. flashlights, camera, etc) being added to our NFPA 1971 certified helmets.

Morning Pride builds helmets to the NFPA Std 1971 / 2000 / 2007 edition helmet standard. Within the standard, the NFPA does not directly address the addition of additional helmet markings, flashlights, or cameras but does provide guidance. We would like to suggest the following guide:

- The helmet should not be altered in any way.
- Any additional markings should meet the trim requirements of the standard
- Any additional accessory (flashlights, cameras, etc) should not detract from the design requirements or performance.

Morning Pride would not void a warranty on a helmet if the individual or fire department follows the NFPA 1971/1851 and the above guidelines. You can in fact purchase extra markings such as crescent title tapes, helmet fronts, passport identification systems, etc from us. Morning Pride also would not void a warranty on a helmet because of attaching an accessory as long as the accessory did not compromise the integrity of the helmet and conformed to NFPA 1971/1851 sections such as 4-8. We urge fire departments to set up SOP's on both of these issues for their members to follow.
